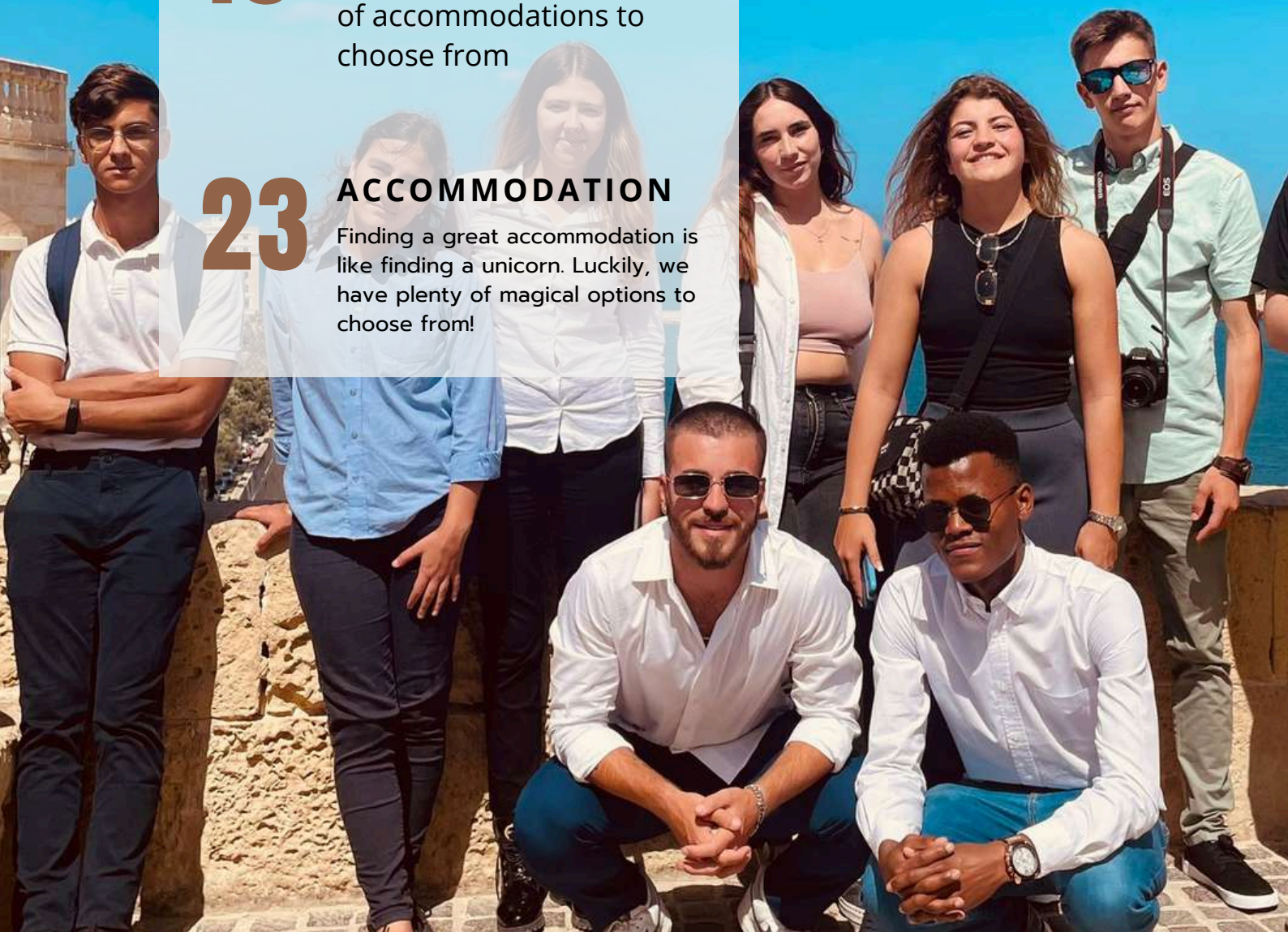

Every programme is carefully curated to offer relevant visitation destinations that cater to the participants' field of study, skills set and professional interests. Who can apply?

Minimum number of participants?

12 students. Accompanying teachers are always welcome.

Maximum number of participants?

When conducting a study visit programme, it is critical to ensure that all participants receive the necessary attention and support. Therefore, it is recommended that a maximum of 60 attendees be set for each programme. This way, we can guarantee that each participant will receive ample attention from guides, facilitators, and other relevant personnel.

WHO CAN APPLY?



Stage Malta's Internship Programmes are intended for students or graduates who at the time of application meet the following requirements:

- Able to communicate and correspond in English. Fluency in the English language is typically mandatory since it is the official language of Malta's business environment;
- Some internships may require having certain technical skills or qualifications relevant to the field of interest, such as IT proficiency or specific software knowledge;
- One must be resilient and open to a new culture and way of living;
- Possess a European passport, European residence permit or in the process of obtaining a Schengen Visa;
- Applicants must be enrolled in a recognized educational institution or have recently graduated from one. This ensures that candidates possess the necessary theoretical background and are committed to further developing their skills in a professional setting;
- Agree to inform Stage Malta of any medical conditions and allergies prior to the Work Placement interview. Able to provide relevant medical documentation should this be requested. This information will remain confidential and will not be deemed as a motive for discrimination;
- Agree to provide Stage Malta with a copy of a full travel insurance at least 1 week before travelling to Malta.

Internships are intended to help students foster a richer grasp of the labour market, gain insights into encountered obstacles, and discover effective solutions. Fulfilling these eligibility criteria guarantees that stagiaires can contribute with confidence to their host organisation and acquire valuable hands-on experience while in Malta.

Internships are not remunerated. The acquisition of the necessary visas, travel costs and arrangements are the responsibility of the interns or their sponsoring institutions.

INTERNSHIP PROCEDURES

The process for our internship programme is designed to be straightforward and efficient. Once we have reviewed an applicant's CV and motivation letter, we internally discuss the potential work plan for the individual. To aid in this process, we request that each applicant provides us with a list of tasks they would like to accomplish during their time with us.

Following this, we conduct a virtual interview to discuss expectations and determine learning outcomes. Once the applicant has signed the necessary training and learning agreements, we eagerly await their flight details. Three weeks prior to their arrival, we send a detailed itinerary for your review. This document includes important information such as addresses, contact details of the mentor and company supervisor, links, and tips for living and working on a Mediterranean island.

Upon arrival, our drivers will greet the student at the airport and take them to their accommodations. We understand that after a long trip, students may not be in the mood for a meeting, so we keep things simple and brief.

The following day, we hold an induction meeting and assign a house-buddy to help them navigate the area and locate necessities such as grocery stores, pharmacies, and banking facilities.

Work begins the day after the induction meeting, and we encourage the student to send us their first impressions of the organisation. We also maintain regular contact with each student, visiting them at their home and company, organising events, and ensuring that their learning outcomes are being met.

Prior to departure, we prepare a performance appraisal, reference letter, and any other necessary paperwork. Each successful student is presented with a certificate to commemorate their achievements.

Our internship programme is designed to provide a valuable learning experience for each participant. We take pride in our thorough and efficient process, and we look forward to welcoming new students to our programme.

TIMELINE

A comprehensive breakdown of preparations undertaken in the 10 weeks preceding the students arrival in Malta.

-10 weeks

By 10 weeks prior to arrival we expect to receive the students' CVs in English (including picture, date of birth, male or female, education and work experience), tasks s/he would like to do during his/her time in Malta, visa and/or passport (valid for EU travel), date of arrival and departure.

-9 weeks (or earlier)

Stage Malta will conduct an individual interview. After that, we await the confirmation of the candidate through a one hundred and fifty euro booking fee. This will then be used as a damage deposit which will be returned in cash by the driver upon departure. However this will not be returned if the candidate cancels or changes his/her dates by more than 2 days from the original application.

-7 weeks

In order to conclude everything in a timely manner, we require copy of the flight ticket for the arrival and departure of the student. At this point we appreciate a final confirmation of whether s/he would like a single or a shared room and if s/he would like to live with any specific friends.

-6 weeks

Time to start preparing by applying for a bus card, think of what clothes (as indicated in the dress code guidelines given) to pack, maybe trying out a few easy recipes and getting used to waking up early.

-4 weeks

A final programme with all details is sent. By then each candidate would have received the name of the company, address, name of supervisor, contact details, accommodation, emergency numbers etc

CLOSER TO ARRIVAL ...

-3 DAYS

The student will receive a whatsapp message to ensure that Stage Malta's emergency line and the driver's number have been saved on their phone.

LANDING

Our colleague will be waiting for the student inside the arrival lounge of Malta's only airport in Luqa.

ARRIVAL

The student will be dropped off at the house where they will be greeted with a welcome pack, a bottle of water and a snack, and given their house key.

THE DAY AFTER

The student is assisted by his/her housemates to find the closest supermarket, bus stop etc.

WELCOME MEETING

We look forward to meeting with the student in our office to celebrate their official start as a stagiaire.

FIRST DAY AT WORK

This thrilling yet terrifying day will serve as the foundation for a prosperous collaboration that is expected to bring benefits to both the stagiaire and the company.

END OF FIRST WEEK

Learning outcomes are reiterated in the work plan to ensure that the Company and the stagiaire are in agreement.

WEEKLY

Stage Malta keeps in touch with all the stagiaires on a weekly basis. We also visit an average of 5 companies a week. It is always a great pleasure seeing the stagiaires in action as they proudly present their achievements.

END OF INTERNSHIP

In recognition of their unwavering resilience, adaptability, and courage throughout the internship, we take great pride in awarding a certificate during our final meeting.

Housing

To enhance every participant's Mediterranean experience and ensure proximity to all necessary facilities, we have curated traditional houses situated in 10 key but remarkably safeguarded locations throughout Malta.

- Each house includes a fully stocked kitchen comprising of a fridge-freezer, hob, oven, microwave along with all the necessary pots, pans, cutlery, plates, glasses, mugs and bowls. Furthermore, a dining area featuring a table and chairs is also provided with emphasis on using high-quality materials;
- Bedrooms are simple yet comfortable (no bunk-beds), with 3-pin plugs to charge electronic devices, simple storage space and a mirror;
- One can book a private single room* or opt for a twin or shared room;
- Mattresses are semi-orthopaedic and the bed linen provided is hypoallergenic and dry cleaned with non-toxic chemicals;
- All houses have outdoor space where trainees can relax and discuss their day with their housemates;
- Upon arrival, each trainee is picked up from the airport and taken to their house and presented with a Welcome Pack, house key and a welcome token;
- Self-service laundry services are available in each house;
- WI-FI, water, electricity and gas is included;
- Throughout their duration at the facility, the trainees can rely on a team comprising of a plumber, electrician, handyman, and housing support staff for constant assistance and ensuring their well-being.

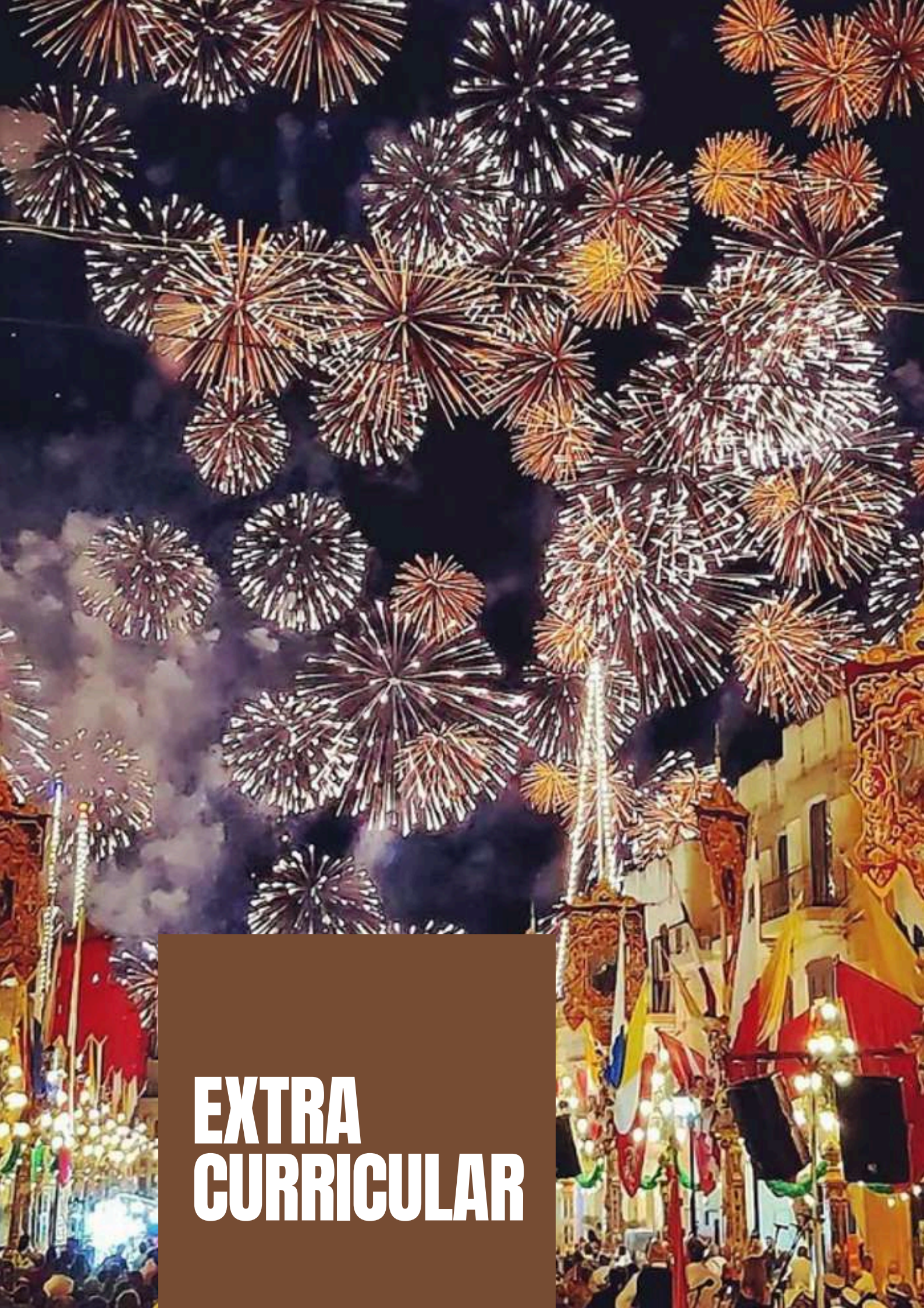
